Applications to Date

1. Byers Gill- 1364 Acres pre application phase. National Planning.
2. Longpasture- 163 Acres awaiting approval from Darlington Borough Council.
3. Whinfield- 150 Acres approved by Darlington Borough Council
4. Gately Moor- 303 Acres approved by Darlington & Stockton Borough Councils.
5. California Farm Letch Ln- 215 Acres awaiting decision from Stockton Borough Council.
6. Letch Lane- 50 Acres approved constructed and in use.
7. Thorpe Bank- 96 Acres approved by Stockton Borough Council.
8. Low Middlefield Farm- 54 Acres approved by Stockton Borough Council.
9. Burtree Lane- 153 Acres awaiting decision by Darlington Borough Council.
10. Hunger Hill Middleton St George- 44.5 Acres approved by Darlington Borough Council.
